Volunteer Case Assignment Limit

Standard 7.D.8: A volunteer will not be assigned more than two (2) cases at a time. An exception may be granted at the discretion of the CASA program staff; however, the decision to permit a higher caseload shall be documented as to the justification for and reasonableness of the exception. Under the exception, a volunteer will not be assigned to more than five (5) cases.

This form must be completed *prior* to appointing a new case to a volunteer *who is already serving at least two (2) cases.* The decision to make additional appointments should be made in light of a variety of factors; including the volunteer's tenure, time and past and present performance.
